#### **FINANCIAL SUMMARY NOVEMBER 2022**

Income for November was \$20,248.00 and was less than planned for by -\$748.35. Expenses for November were \$19,589.15 and were less than the planned expenses by -\$1,452.83. November income of \$20,248.00 less November expenses of \$19,589.15 means we took in more money than we spent by +\$658.85. YTD income of \$236,453 less YTD expenses of \$251,516 leaves us with a loss of \$15,064. Hopefully as the Winter Texans start returning donations will increase and we will be able to minimize our year to date loss. Thank you all for mailing in or dropping off your donations. #### Our Savior's Quilters the "Piecemakers"

Heavenly Father, We thank you for food and remember the hungry. We thank you for friends and remember the friendless. We thank you for freedom and remember the enslaved. May these remembrances stir us to service that your gifts to us be used for others. In the name of the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. Amen.

In the beginning...... The year of 2003 the Piecemakers at Our Savior's, a group of seasonal and permanent Rio Grande Valley residents (not limited to members of Our Savior church) began their work. Present at the organizational meeting were Alice Johnson, Betty Cooksley, Norma Grotewald, Barb Rush, Ann Grimsted, Ruth Peterson, Eleanor Stapf, Rayoma Andrews and Macel Magnussen. During 2003-04 season, they donated 35 quilts to the Colonia and ten quilts to Comfort House. And presented a quilt to each child baptized at OSLC. The Piecemakers have made over 5700 quilts since its inception. One year the records show 466 were made. This year, the blessing of 320 plus quilts is Sunday, January 8. These quilts are given to various schools in the McAllen area. The children who receive one are very appreciative. The group also works with the Salvation Army throughout the year. You may also purchase one for the donation of \$75.00 each.

There are six steps: 1) Cut fabric blocks of 8 x 9 (or experience quilters may do smaller) 2) Arrange blocks in design of 60 x 80 size quilt top 3) Sew blocks together 4) Pin together a "sandwich" of top-batting-bottom 5) Secure layers by making knots approximately 5 inches apart over complete surface 6) Fold lower fabric up and over the top fabric to bind the two together and sew the binding along the edge. There is so much pride in this work that each quilt has an extra step of sewing a label on the quilt that reads (Spanish and English) "When you wrap yourself in this quilt, may you feel the loving arms of our Lord. personally blessed and comes with our love and prayers". Which also included Our Savior's address and phone number.

The group welcomes any monetary donations and or donations of fabric, new or slightly used sheets and thread. These donations may be sent or brought to Our Savior. Mark in the memo line of your check *Piecemakers*.


